The Lanchester Partnership DATA PROTECTION - PRIVACY STATEMENT

WHAT DATA DO WE COLLECT?

Your data comprises the information collected on the Membership Application/Renewal Form which links to any records of donations you have made to the Partnership.

HOW WE USE YOUR DATA

The personal data you provide on this form will be used to meet Lanchester Partnership's legitimate interests of community engagement, village development, fundraising and event/project support. We will use your data to manage our on-going relationship and engagement with you, and to send you communications about news, developments, projects, events, volunteering opportunities, fundraising and progress updates from organisations and societies which contribute to the Partnership. We will also use your data to:

- Record and/or update your contact details and communication preferences,
- Record any interactions or contributions you have made including financial donations you might make occasionally or annually

WHO HAS ACCESS TO YOUR DATA?

The data you provide will be stored and processed in accordance with the Partnerships' policies and procedures via our membership management system. The Partnership acts as a "data controller," meaning that you can contact us if you have questions about your data.

DATA SHARING

On extremely rare occasions we may also wish to share your data with third parties working on our behalf to assist with our communications (e.g. mailing houses, printers), events (e.g. external venues, caterers) and donations. We will only do this in appropriate circumstances, for specified purposes, by secure means, and with the relevant data sharing agreements in place. **We do not and will not sell your data under any circumstances.**

HOW LONG WE KEEP YOUR DATA

We consider our relationship with members, donors and supporters to be life-long and we will retain most of your data indefinitely, unless you request otherwise.

YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to:

- Opt-out of direct communications at any time.
- Request access to and correction or erasure of your data
- Request transfer of your data to another party
- Object to the processing of your data or request that such processing is restricted.
